



ASSOCIATION MEETING AGREEMENT

Rule 795(d)(3) supports non-traditional CLE credit for bar association or professional association meetings. Association meetings at which professionalism, diversity (inclusion), mental illness and addiction issues (wellness), civility, or legal ethics are discussed shall be eligible for professional responsibility CLE credit. These discussions are required to have significant intellectual, educational or practical content related to the practice of law and the primary objective is to increase each participant's professional competence as an attorney.

Association meetings are eligible for a maximum of one hour of professional responsibility credit per meeting.

For a bar or professional association to administer professional responsibility credit for meetings that qualify for professional responsibility CLE credit pursuant to [Rule 795\(d\)\(3\)](#), the Association shall sign and return to 2Civility the following signed agreement.

AGREEMENT

2Civility agrees to extend approval to the _____ to administer “non-traditional” professional responsibility CLE credit for meetings at which substantive law, matters of practice, professionalism, diversity issues, mental illness and addiction issues, civility, or legal ethics are discussed, subject to the following assurances:

1. Association assures that 2Civility's Professional Responsibility Education Guidelines will be utilized to the design meetings where professional responsibility credit is administered.
2. Association assures that meetings for which credit is provided relate primarily to the practice of law and that there is significant intellectual, educational, or practical content to increase participant competence as an attorney.
3. Association assures one credit hour equals 60 minutes; partial credit hour will be rounded down to nearest quarter hour; minimum credit equals one-half hour; and credit hour does not include breaks, introductory and closing remarks, keynote speeches or business meeting. Association meetings are eligible for a maximum of one hour of professional responsibility credit per meeting.
4. Association assures the maintenance of a list all attendees at meetings for a period of three years and the issuance of a certificate to each participant verifying attendance and professional responsibility hours earned.
